School Funding

In January, God's Kids funded the next 6 months of tuition for the 31 students in elementary and secondary school as well as for 4 orphans now attending college and trade schools. A goal of God's Kids has always been to support children through college or trade schools and this is one of the locations where we are now starting to do this.

School Supplies

In addition to paying for tuition, God's Kids also sent funding for school supplies, new textbooks, and uniforms.





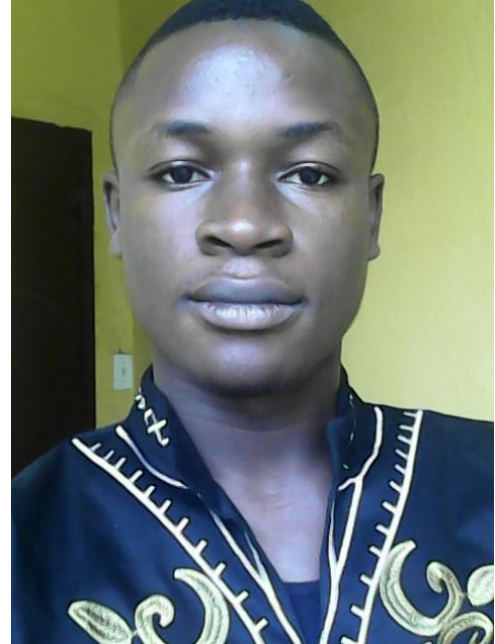

He is now finishing up his second year of college and has shared with us that his goal is to make Liberian health facilities better and safer as well as raising the standard of care for Liberians.

Project Dignity Update

Last year, God's Kids funded the start of a new project in Liberia that we named "Project Dignity". The goal of Project Dignity is to bring safe drinking water as well as bathrooms to impoverished cities in Liberia. Phase 1 is nearly complete as the first new drinking tower has been installed.

Once the water pump is in place, a bathroom will be built next to the water tower. A total of 6 of these water tower and bathroom stations are set to be built over the next few years.

Medical Checkups

The Village of Hope team had a pediatrician come out recently to do a health and wellness check on the children. The children are all healthy and doing well.

School Funding

At the beginning of April, God's Kids funded a few school related expenses for Village of Hope including tuition and school supplies for the children at VOH. We also supported a few orphans going to college and trade schools as well as two adults who work at the orphanage who are continuing their education for counseling the children.

Transportation Costs

The staff at the God's Kids orphanage in Thailand recently had training a few hours away from the orphanage. We covered the cost of transportation so our orphanage directors could get training from an orphanage training organization.

We also covered transportation costs for one of our orphans to go to his native city to get his Thai ID, allowing him to become a Thai citizen.
